Application and Notification Timeline

- Bid application process opens the week of January 6, 2025
- Completed bids must be received on or before 5:00PM EST on January 31, 2025.
- National Horse Show (NHS) will notify the selected host competitions within 20 days of bid closing date.
- Additional requirements to host the Regional competition will be sent with the host agreement. The host
 competition will be required to execute and return the host agreement within fourteen (14) days of
 verified receipt of delivery.

Requirements:

The Host Event agrees to provide the following at its sole expense:

- All facilities and equipment including the show ring with suitable footing, schooling areas, jumps, stabling, sound system and other communications equipment, appropriate decorations, signage, personnel (Steward, Vet, Farrier, Jump Crew, Announcer, etc.), press accommodations, office space with telephones, food services, security and fire safety, EMT and ambulance in compliance with USEF regulations, and sanitation services.
- Lodging and transportation for Maclay Regional Championship judges and course designers
- Two black and white full-page advertisements (copy to be supplied by the NHS) in the Host Event's program and prize list.
- VIP table for any participating sponsors for the duration of the Host Event.
- PA announcements during the Maclay Regional Championship classes for the NHS, ASPCA and any participating sponsors. Copy for said announcements will be coordinated with the NHS.
- Suitable trade booth space for participating sponsors to distribute information and solicit donations.
- Suitable placement of banners and jump logos in arena, as well as a sponsor jump, if available.
- Coordination with NHS on media coverage, including press release to local media based on copy supplied provided by the NHS.
- If a sponsorship for the event is secured, the sponsor would be entitled to a rider's lounge with food and beverage as well as computer terminal hook ups and customized rider numbers for the Maclay Regional Championship.

Fees:

- There is no charge by the NHS to the Host Event to hold the Regional Maclay Championship. However, all entry fees for the Maclay Regional Championship class are to be paid directly to, and become the sole property of, the NHS. While the Host Event may not charge any additional fees directly related to a rider's participation in the Maclay Regional Championship class it may charge for stabling and/or other classes, including warm-up classes, in which a Maclay Regional Championship class participant may wish to compete.
- The Host Event is responsible for collecting and remitting to USEF and USHJA any required fees.

Officials:

- All Maclay Regional Championship judges and judge pairings must be approved by the NHS prior to the
 printing of the Host Event's prize list. The Host Event must use one judge from a list provided by the
 NHS. The second judge, pending approval of the NHS, may be a judge already engaged by the Host
 Event. Whenever possible, the Host Event is encouraged to provide at least one judge that has not
 judged any of the equitation classes at the competition prior to judging the Regional Championship.
- All Maclay Regional Championship course designers must be approved by the NHS prior to the printing
 of the Host Event's prize list.
